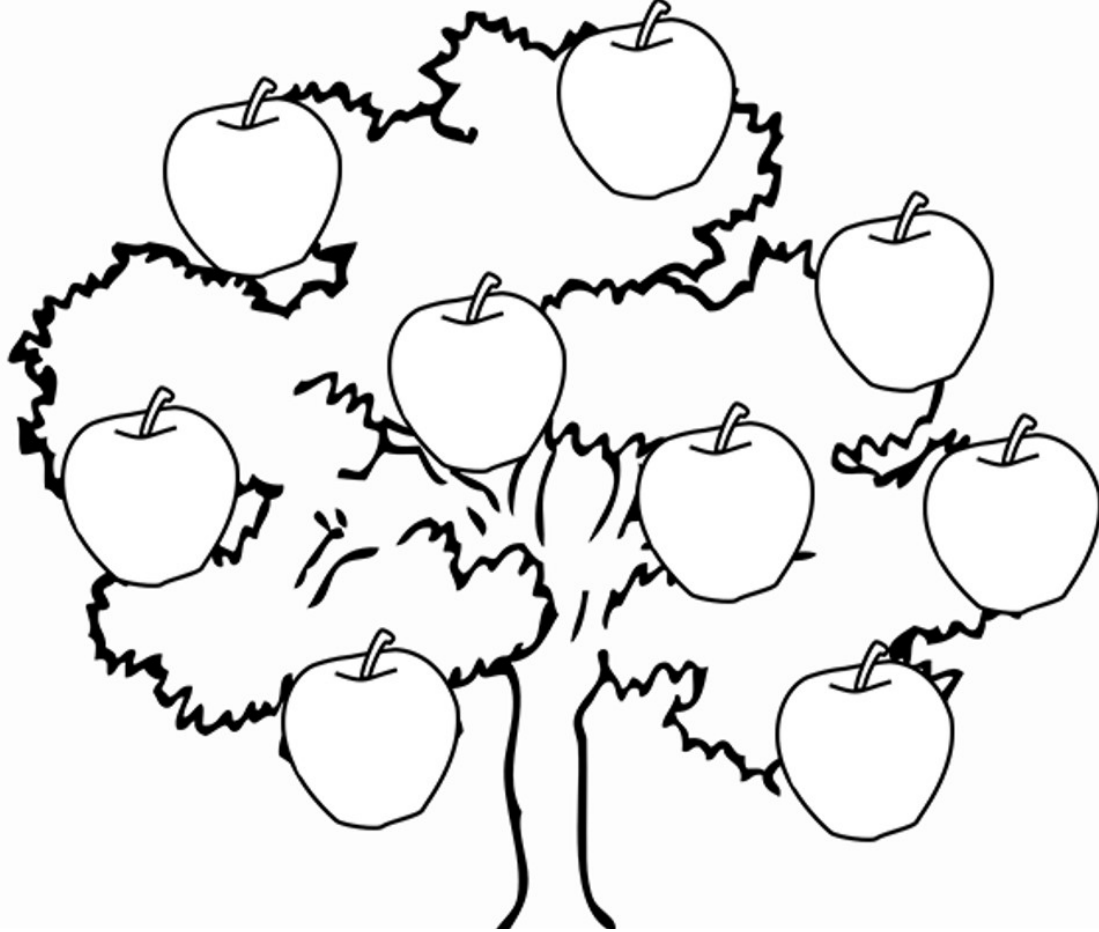
*Genesis 1:1-31 – 2:3*

# Fruits of the Spirit

Galatians 5:22-23 says the fruit of the Spirit is **love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control.**

9. **Caring for people** even if you are strangers or enemies
