Collecting stuff for Easter

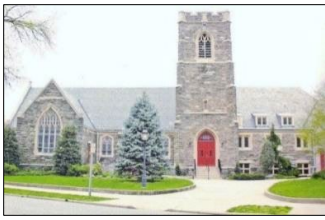
February 12th - March 19th there will be a bin in the narthex for collection of Easter candy and treats (stuff like erasers, stickers, pencils.)
